

WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Acknowledgement of Duty of Care

The Board of Directors of Aurora Energy Metals Ltd (the Board) acknowledges the duty of care incumbent upon us to ensure that the well-being of the people we employ, whether directly or as contractors, and those who may be affected by our business activities is an absolute priority and must be considered at all times.

Primary Objectives

The objectives of this policy are to, as far as is reasonably practicable:

- consider Work Health and Safety (WHS) principles, legislation and regulations in the planning of all projects and exploration activities
- involve employees and contractors in the decision-making process through regular communication and consultation
- ensure that employees, contractors and sub-contractors identify hazards and implement measures to control risks in the workplace
- monitor and review the effectiveness of risk controls regularly
- enhance WHS awareness and knowledge of our employees, contractors and sub-contractors through education and training.

Integrity of WHS Management System

The successful implementation and execution of our WHS management system depends on:

- the commitment of all employees, contractors and sub-contractors to achieve the policy objectives
- the planning of all work activities, giving due consideration to WHS principles and legislative requirements
- the effective management of known risks through the identification of all potential physical and psychosocial hazards and their associated risk exposures, and the maintenance of a comprehensive register covering all relevant risks within each risk category

- communication and consultation between our employees, contractors and sub-contractors.

We are committed to fulfilling the objectives of this policy and we shall encourage and expect the same commitment from all our employees, contractors and sub-contractors who conduct work on our behalf.
